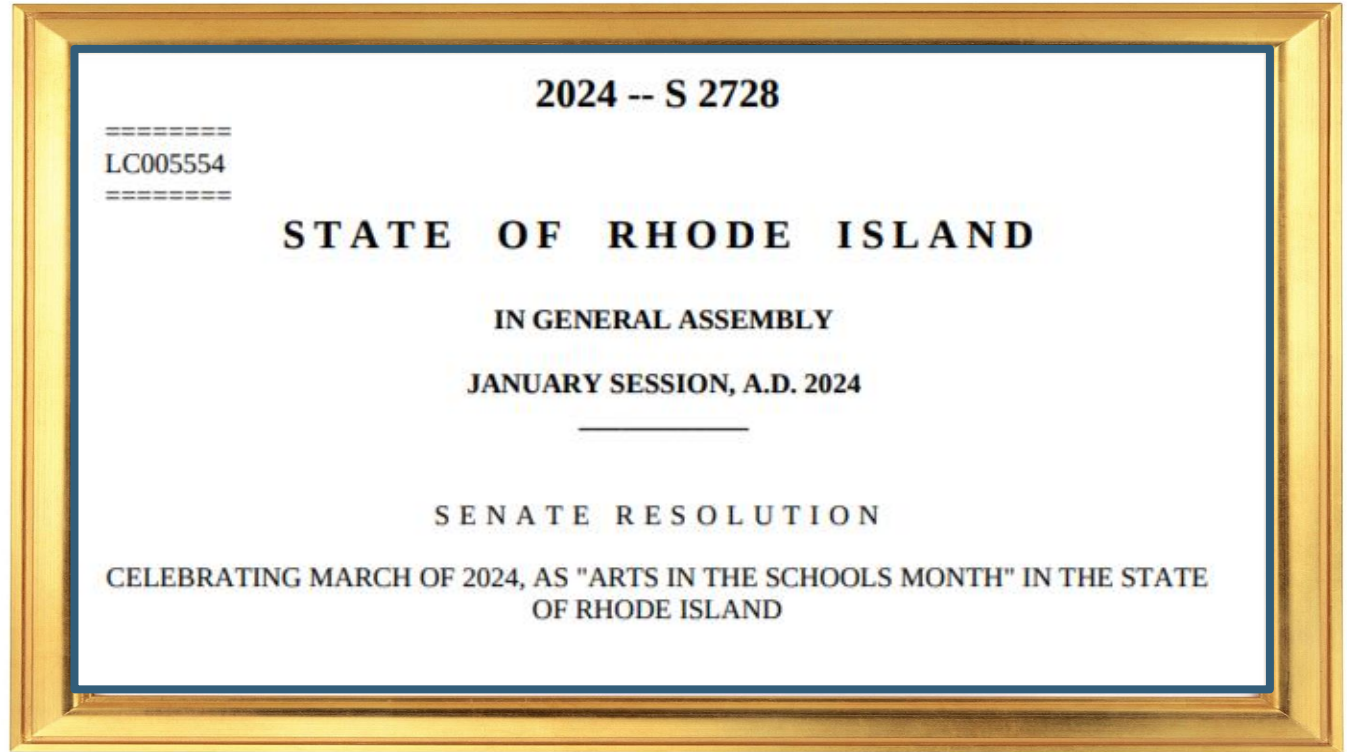

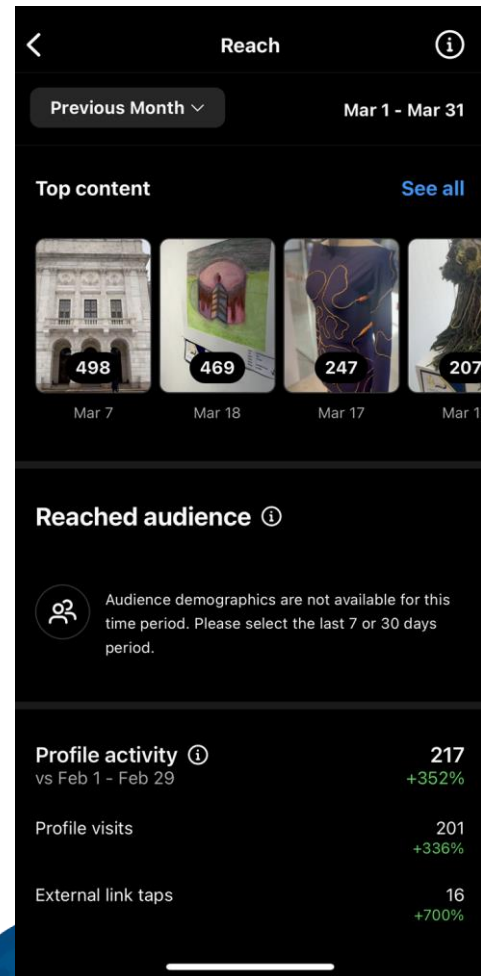
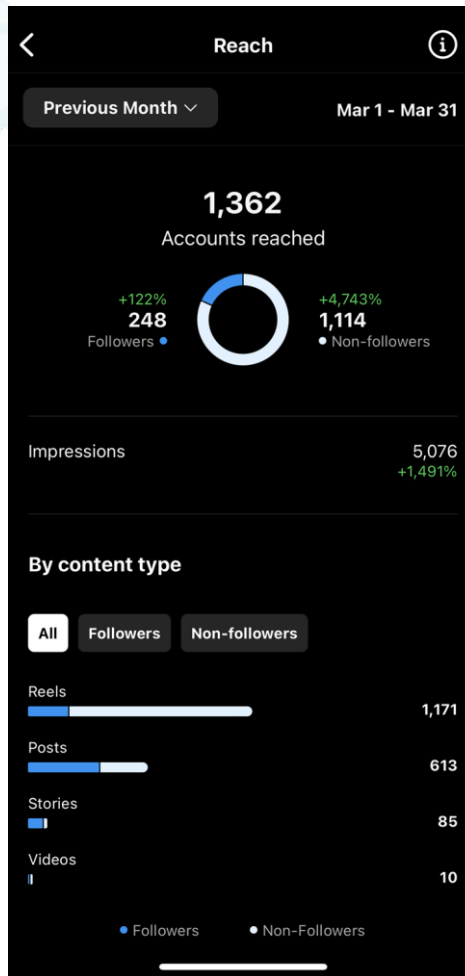
Program Improvements
